Storm Drain Line and Catch Basin Work

Public Service crew jetted storm drain lines on Pine Street, and repaired the storm drain box on Pine Street as well. Also repaired a section of drain pipe at the Mountain View Cemetary, and cleaned two driveway culverts on Biblebrook Road.

Streets

Patched 38 potholes in various locations. We also picked up trash on Highway 80, and replaced a sections of curb line on Annandale Court. We crack sealed several locations in Lismore Park as well.

Public Service

The Public Service crew hauled e-waste, and construction waste from the old shop to the landfill as needed. And delivered new carts to the residents. They also restriped the city parking lot behind the GDC Office, and replaced 150 feet of sidewalk on Moore Street.

Street Sweeper

We ran the street sweeper 15 days on the city streets, and curb lines.

Grass Cutting

We cut the grass, and ran bush hog on the right of way throughout the city. Also cut the grass at the City Cemetary. And sprayed curb-lines, and sidewalks for weeds.

Signs

Repaired, or replaced 13 signs throughout the city as needed. Also replaced breakaway post, sign post, also bolts, and nuts, when needed.
