



ORDINANCE NUMBER 18 – 2016

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE CITY OF GREER PUBLIC WORKS FEE AND ESTABLISH A CITY OF GREER SANITATION FEE

WHEREAS, the City of Greer City Council wishes to repeal Ordinance 3-2010 establishing a Public Works Fee and setting provisions for its collection therein; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Greer City Council wishes to establish a fee schedule for properties eligible to receive sanitation services in accordance with the City of Greer's Code of Ordinances and its policies and standards; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Greer City Council shall review the fee schedule for sanitation services as necessary to insure that expenses related to sanitation services provided by the City of Greer are sufficiently funded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Greer, South Carolina in Council assembled that:

Ordinance 3-2010 establishing a Public Works Fee on each parcel incorporated within the City of Greer, and setting provisions for its collection therein, is hereby repealed.

The City of Greer hereby amends the City of Greer Comprehensive Fee Schedule to remove the Public Works Fee and to include a schedule of fees which may be adjusted from time to time by City Council in order to maintain an Enterprise Fund sufficient to fund expenses required to provide sanitation services in the City of Greer.


The City of Greer Comprehensive Fee Schedule shall include a Residential Sanitation Fee for the provision of residential sanitation services to be levied in the amount of \$115.00 annually per residential unit on each residential parcel incorporated within the City of Greer that is eligible to receive sanitation services in accordance to and compliance with the City of Greer Code of Ordinances Chapter 74 – Solid Waste.

Sanitation fees levied within the City of Greer shall be billed as the "City of Greer Sanitation Fee" on property tax notices generated by the Auditor Office, and collected by the County Treasurer, of the County of

Greenville, South Carolina and the County of Spartanburg, South Carolina.


This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon second reading approval thereof.
